Cordero Grav (USA)

- K of C 50m champion in 2012, 2013, 2017, 2nd in 2015
- K of C 60m champion in 2013, 2014, 2nd in 2016
- "Invitational Athlete of the Meet" in 2014
- 3rd in K of C 50m in 2018
- making his 8th K of C appearance

Bryce Robinson (USA)

- 8-time All-American for U of Tulsa
- 2-time World University Games silver medalist
- 2018 won K of C 60m and was 2nd in 50m
- 2018 5th fastest in W for 60m

Blake Smith (USA

- won 15 medals and 4 conference titles for Southeast Missouri State U in Ohio Valley Conference
- 2018 K of C 50m champion equalling the record and ran 2nd in the 60m
- 2018 7th fastest in W for 60m

Sean McLean (USA, Allstarz Mgmt)

- starred at Word of God Academy (Raleigh, NC)
- 2011 Pan American Junior medalist (2nd at 100m and 1st in 4 x 100m)
- equal 6th fastest 60m by an American in 2014 at 6.55sec
- bests of 6.55sec at 60m and 10.01 at 100m

D'Angelo Cherry (USA)

- ran a best of 6.60 in 2017 to equal the 6th fastest time by an American
- 6th fastest 60m in US college history
- US and NCAA indoor champion in 2013
- 3rd in 2018 K of C 60m

Desmond Lawrence (USA)

- All American star at North Carolina A & T
- drafted by Cincinnati Bengals in 2015 and rated the second fastest two-sport college athlete in the USA
- ran a best of 6.60 for 60m in 2018

Stephen Abosi (Canada, U of Calgary Athletic Club)

- 10th fastest Canadian at 60m in 2018 (6.77)

Roland Dodoo (Canada, Oakville Legion TC)

- member of Athletics Canada's development program
- in 2018 had pb's of 6.84 (60m) and 10.36 (100m)

Adam Harris (Guyana, Codrington Elite Performance)

- 8-time Big Ten conference champion in 60m, 100m, 200m, long jump and relay
- 3-time Big Ten Track Athlete of the Year
- represented Guyana in the 2008 Olympics in the 200m

Benjamin Williams (Canada, Voleo TC)

- -4 x 100m silver medalist for Canada in 2017 Francophone games and bronze in the NACAC U23 champs
- -4th fastest Canadian of 2018 for 60m at 6.71 and 10th at 100m (10.27)
- -bests of 10.23 in the 100m and 20.79 at 200m

Ryan Billian (USA)

- competed at U of Buffalo
- multi-talented athlete medalling in conference championships in all four years in sprints, hurdles, long jump and relays
- bests of 6.76 in the 60m and 7.86 on 60m hurdles

Karson Lehner (Canada, U of S)

- -in 2017 he was the #1 Saskatchewan 300m runner finishing 3rd in Canada West and 7th at Usport
- -has best of 34.32 and has run 6.98 and 35.03 this season
